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AMERICAN CURRICULUM

The American curriculum is based on American standards of achievement in all subject areas, supported by a huge range of co-curricular activities that ensure students have the opportunity to develop fully as individuals. Any American curriculum refers to a broad and balanced Kindergarten to Year 12 [K-12] program commencing with entry to Kindergarten at age 5 and concluding with the award of the American High School Diploma on successful completion of Grade 12, at age 17. The American diploma is accepted for entrance by all US universities and colleges, and is increasingly recognized by international schools of higher education.

INDIAN CURRICULUM

Indian curriculum offers curricula from the CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education) and the CISCE (Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations). The CBSE curriculum is designed and developed by the National Council of Educational Research and Training, New Delhi, and prepares students for the All India CBSE Secondary Schools Examination at age 16 – end of grade 10 – and the All India Senior School Certificate Examination at age 18 – end of grade 12. The CISCE curriculum prepares students for the ISCE examination in the secondary school and the ISC (Indian School Certificate) examination in the final year of secondary school.

Both curricula provide a platform for the development of diverse intelligences in children and provide multiple avenues for developing every child's potential. Subjects studied include business studies, informatics and Indian languages as well as more traditional subjects such as Maths and English.

The examinations for both curricula prepare students for entrance exams to Indian universities to which there are direct curricular links, and also to universities worldwide.
