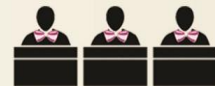

Debate

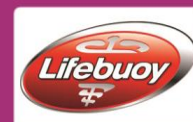


Competitive debating is an activity in which two sides are discussing opposing points about a particular issue with the aim of persuading people. Each side is either in favor of (Pro) or opposed to (Con) the topic. Both sides must assemble and organize the effective arguments to persuade the audience using clear language. Debaters are given 10 minutes time to deliver their speech.

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Topics:

🗨️ **Semi Final** (All Participating schools)
Topic: "Can teaching machines replace teachers nowadays and/or in the future?"

🗨️ **Final** (only 1st and 2nd class winners)
Topic: "Should students be allowed to use cell phone and electronic devices in the class?"
